<b>F</b> luency	<b>Popcorn Words (Sight Words)</b> These are words your student needs to know by heart for this week.  <b>afraid, flew, join, learn, wonder, nothing, thought</b>
<b>E</b> xpanded Vocabulary	<b>Inflections -ed, -ing</b> This week we will be reviewing how to drop the final e to add inflections -ed, -ing.
